We distinguish here between ' traditional ' graduate occupations (e.g. solicitors, doctors, scientists, lecturers, secondary school teachers) and ' modern ' graduate occupations - the newer professions which graduates have been entering since the expansion of higher education in the 1960s (e.g. senior managers in large organisations, IT professionals, primary school teachers).

This classification allocates each of the official 800 Italian occupational categories to four groups distinguishing between ' graduate ' and ' non-graduate ' groups on the basis of their relative levels of knowledge and skills requirements.
