Clinical Documentation and Record Keeping | 3 Guideline: Clinical Documentation and Record Keeping Guideline: Provides recommendations to regulated members that are deemed to be acceptable practice within regulatory requirements. Regulated members are afforded reasonable use of their professional judgment in the application of a guideline.

Documentation of the originating site location and personnel. Components of a clinical encounter which should be documented include: Chief Complaint or Reason for Encounter. Referral Source. History of Present Illness. Current Treatments including medications and ongoing therapies. Mental Status Examination.

Clinical Documentation - American Psychiatric Association

The documentation should always be clear, concise, and to the highest level of

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specificity so that it paints the most accurate clinical picture. Although ICD-10-CM is used to report diagnoses in all settings, different guidelines apply for inpatient and outpatient settings, which may not be understood by providers working in both settings.

Clinical Practice Guidelines. “ Clinical practice guidelines are systematically developed statements to assist practitioner and patient decisions about appropriate health care for specific clinical circumstances. ” (Institute of Medicine, 1990) Issued by third-party organizations, and not NCCIH, these guidelines define the role of specific diagnostic and treatment modalities in the diagnosis and management of patients.

THIRD-PARTY ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUESTS Upon request for a review, it is the billing provider ' s responsibility to obtain supporting documentation as needed from a referring physician ' s office (for example, physician order, notes to support medical necessity) or from an inpatient facility (for example, progress note).
